

The Peruvian Journal of Gynecology and Obstetrics Essential requirements for receipt of an article for publication

If these requirements are not met, the manuscript will be returned to the author for modification.

- Submit the manuscript as an MS Word document (not PDF); make sure that the manuscript has an abstract, resumen, Vancouver style references and figure legends (if applicable).
- Submit the title page and manuscript as separate MS Word documents (not PDF).
- Include a cover letter.
- Comply with double-blind peer review requirements.
- Submit the authorship affidavit filled out by each author.
- Submit the completed checklist required as an appendix to the manuscript.
- Address Good Publication Practices in industry-funded studies.
- Document (in the cover letter) that written patient consent for publication has been obtained (applies for articles containing descriptions of individual patients, such as Case Reports).
- In the case of a clinical trial, include the registration number and dates of enrollment, as well as the approval of the institution's ethics committee.
- Include ClinicalTrials.gov and MEDLINE in the literature search when conducting a Systematic Review.

Automatic Rejection

Manuscripts will be automatically rejected if

- Authors do not obtain written consent from the patient for publication (in the case of articles containing descriptions of individual patients, such as Case Reports).
- Authors of a clinical trial do not obtain approval by the institution's ethics committee and, depending on the type of trial, do not prospectively register the trial before enrolling patients.
- The response rate to clinical surveys is less than 60%.
